If you entered Springfield College in 2022-2023, use this guide for sequencing your courses. Requirements are subject to change and may not be offered when listed. Use your online degree audit to verify your progress, and always confirm your plans with your advisor.

Core Curriculum Requirements, Electives, and College Requirements

In addition to the major requirements listed below, you will need to fill the following General Education (GenEd) categories:

- 100-level Wellness & Physical (1 cr)
- Literature (3 cr)
- Quantitative Reasoning (3 cr)
- Spiritual and Ethical (3 cr) Historical and Social (3 cr)
- Themed Explorations (9 cr)
 - > 3 different prefixes
 - I Global course

- 200-level Wellness & Physical (1 cr)
- 300-level Wellness & Physical (1 cr) Scientific Reasoning (4 cr)

This major typically requires 69 credits to complete. In addition to the Core Curriculum and major requirements listed, you must complete:

- 14 elective credits or more to total at least 120 credits
- The residency requirement—45 credits taken at Springfield College (including 15 of your last 30)
