



# Springfield College Sequencing Guide Art Therapy Major (ATPY) ▼ 2021-2022

If you entered Springfield College in 2021-2022, use this guide for sequencing your courses. Requirements are subject to change and may not be offered when listed. Use your online degree audit to verify your progress, and always confirm your plans with your advisor.

## Core Curriculum Requirements, Electives, and College Requirements

In addition to the major requirements listed below, you will need to fill the following General Education (GenEd) categories:

This major typically requires 69 credits to complete. In addition to the Core Curriculum and major requirements listed, you must complete:

- **14 elective credits or more** to total at least 120 credits
- The **residency requirement**—45 credits taken at Springfield College (including 15 of your last 30)

### ATPY Major Requirements – Typical First-Year Schedule

**Fall:**

SCSM 101, Springfield College Seminar (Core requirement – 3 cr)  
ENGL 113, College Writing I (Core requirement – 3 cr)  
ATPY 101, Introduction to Art Therapy (3 cr)  
Plus other Core and major requirements, or electives to total approximately 15 credits

**Spring:**

ENGL 114, College Writing II (Core requirement – 3 cr)  
ATPY 105, Methods and Materials of Art Therapy (3 cr)  
Plus other Core and major requirements, or electives to total approximately 30 credits for the year

**Fall or Spring:**

ARTS 108, Studio in Drawing (3 cr – also fills Aesthetic Expression Core)  
ARTS 111, Studio in Design (3 cr)  
PSYC 101, Introduction to Psychology (3 cr)

### ATPY Major Requirements – Typical Second-Year Schedule

**Fall or Spring:**

ATPY 203, Art Therapy with Special Populations (3 cr)  
ATPY 430, Multicultural Issues in Art Therapy (3 cr)  
Plus other Core and major requirements, or electives to total approximately 30 credits for the year

### ATPY Major Requirements – Typical Third-Year Schedule

**Fall or Spring:**

ATPY 309, Pre-Practicum in Art Therapy (3 cr)  
Plus other Core and major requirements, or electives to total approximately 30 credits for the year

### ATPY Major Requirements – Typical Fourth-Year Schedule

**Fall or Spring:**

ATPY 470, Advanced Studio (3 cr)  
ATPY 482, Art Therapy Capstone Seminar (3 cr)  
ATPY 484, Practicum in Art Therapy (3 cr)  
Plus other Core and major requirements, or electives to total 120 credits
