



## Springfield College Creative Writing Minor ▼ 2019-2020

If you matriculated to Springfield College in 2019-2020, use this as a guide for completing the Creative Writing minor. Requirements listed for this minor are subject to change—use your online degree audit for the most accurate information. Always confirm your plans with your minor advisor or the chairperson of the Literature, Writing and Journalism department.

### CWRT Minor – 15 Credits Required

ENGL 226, Creative Writing (3 cr)

Select **one course** (3 credits) from the following:

- ENGL 306, Writing and Reading Poetry (3 cr)
- ENGL 307, Writing and Reading Fiction (3 cr)
- ENGL 308, Writing and Reading Creative Non-fiction (3 cr)

Select **three courses** (9 credits) from the following:

- ENGL 235, English Internship (3 cr)
- ENGL 301, Advanced Composition (3 cr)
- ENGL 305, Writing for the Professions (3 cr)

Genre courses, such as:

- ENGL 225, American Drama (3 cr)
- ENGL 246, American Short Story (3 cr)
- ENGL 270, Nature and Environmental Writers (3 cr)
- ENGL 349, Modern American Poetry (3 cr)
- ENGL 350, Modern American Novel (3 cr)

*(special topic offerings may also qualify as genre courses—consult with your advisor for more information)*

### CWRT Minor Program Standards

Program standards for the CRWR minor include:

- At least three of the five courses must be taken at Springfield College.
- Only one of your minor courses also can be used to satisfy a major requirement.
- Only one of your minor courses also can be used to satisfy another minor's requirement.
- You must earn a minimum GPA of 2.500 for all courses used for the minor.
