

Credit Awards for Advanced Placement Examinations

Springfield College awards undergraduate credit for achievement on Advanced Placement (AP) examinations according to the chart below. Note that the minimum score required varies by examination and that course equivalencies may vary according to the score achieved. Credits for AP examinations are considered transfer credits, and will not fulfill the residency requirement. Some majors may limit program requirements that can be completed through examination programs. To award credit, the Academic Advising Center must receive an official score report directly from the College Board. For information about AP, go to collegeboard.org.
