

Credit Awards for CLEP—College Level Examination Program

Springfield College awards undergraduate credit for achievement on CLEP examinations according to the chart below. **Several CLEP examinations are NOT eligible for credit.** Note that the minimum score required varies by examination, and that course equivalencies may vary according to the score achieved. Credits for CLEP examinations are considered transfer credits, and will not fulfill the residency requirements. Credit will not be awarded for any course previously taken at the College with an unsatisfactory grade. Some majors may limit program requirements that can be completed through any combination of examination programs. To award credit, the Academic Advising Center must receive an official score report directly from the College Board. For information about CLEP, go to the CLEP website, clep.collegeboard.org.
