HSRV Major Requirements

All students must complete the following 36 credits. Courses are best taken in the following sequence:

- HUSB 100, Intro to Human Services (3 cr)
- HUSB 109, Group Dynamics (3 cr)
- HUSB 201, Theories of Oppression (3 cr – also fills WAC requirement)
- HUSB 210, Political Economy, Democracy & Community Development (3 cr; HUSB 201 is a prerequisite)
- HUSB, 225, Dynamics of Case Management (3 cr)
- HUSB 268, Fundamentals of Program Evaluation (3 cr)
- HUSB 305, Issues in Research (3 cr - also fills WAC requirement)
- HUSB 308, Public Finance (3 cr; Quantitative Reasoning GenEd is a prerequisite)
- PROJ 350, Practicum I (3 cr; HUSB 109 & HUSB 305 are prerequisites)
- PROJ 351, Practicum II (3 cr; PROJ 350 is a prerequisite)
- HUSB 401, Health & Human Services Policy (3 cr; PROJ 350 is a prerequisite)
- HUSB 416, Senior Seminar (3 cr; should be taken in final semester)

Electives and College Requirements

- Additional elective courses to reach **120 credits required for graduation**
- A **minimum cumulative GPA** of 2.000 or higher
- The **residency requirement**—45 credits taken at Springfield College (including 15 of your last 30)
