- CRIM 215, Gender, Race and Crime (3 credits)
- CRIM 220, Law Enforcement (3 credits)
- CRIM 240, Criminal Procedure (3 credits)
- CRIM 260, Criminology (3 credits – also fills half of WAC GenEd)
- CRIM 375, Research Methods in Criminal Justice (3 credits)
- CRIM 494, Criminal Justice Senior Seminar (3 credits)

In addition, you must select **four selective courses** (12 credits):

- CRIM 270, Constitutional Law (3 credits)

## Elective and College Requirements
