



Springfield College Spanish Minor ▼ 2018-2019

If you matriculated to Springfield College in 2018-2019, use this as a guide for completing the Spanish minor. Requirements listed for this minor are subject to change—use your online degree audit for the most accurate information. Always confirm your plans with your minor advisor or the chairperson of the Humanities department.

SPAN Minor – 15 Credits Required

To receive a minor in Spanish, students must participate in an approved study abroad program. All 15 semester hours are taken overseas. Student select courses from the host institution. The following are required areas for the minor: conversation, grammar and composition, and literature. Course preapproval is required for all courses. Prerequisites for this minor are:

1. Successful completion of the fourth semester of college-level Spanish, or permission of the advisor for the Spanish minor.
2. A cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher; a GPA of 3.00 or higher in all Spanish courses.
3. Placement at intermediate level or higher in the placement exams administered at the host university.
