How Do I Prepare for a Zoom Meeting?

Make sure you have a working microphone and webcam.

2

Test you webcam and microphone prior to your Zoom class by joining the [Zoom Equipment Test Meeting](#).

After clicking the link above, follow the prompts to download Zoom and enter you into the test meeting.

Once you are in the Zoom Equipment Test Meeting, watch [this short video](#) on how to make sure your microphone and webcam are working.

Once your microphone and webcam are working, leave the meeting by pressing “Leave Meeting” in the bottom right hand corner of the meeting.

When it is time to enter your class meeting, locate the link that was provided by your instructor to enter your Zoom meeting.
